2

Prepare communities for significant growth in dementia population.

3

Ensure well-being and safety of people living with dementia and their family caregivers.

4

Ensure access to comprehensive supports for family caregivers.

5

Identify dementia early, and provide dementia-capable, evidenced based health care.

6

Ensure affordable, high quality, coordinated long-term services and supports (LTSS) available in the setting of choice.

7

Promote research and innovation into the causes and effective interventions for dementia.

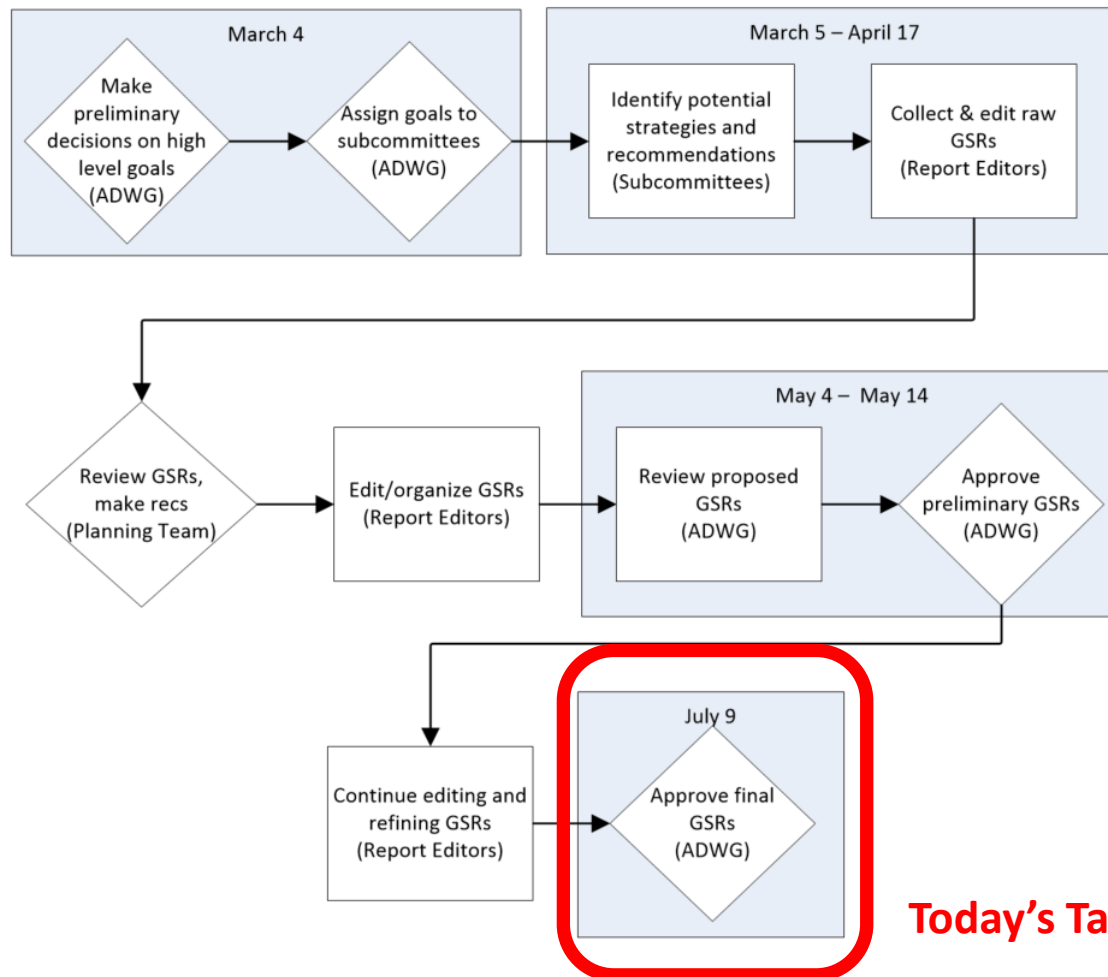

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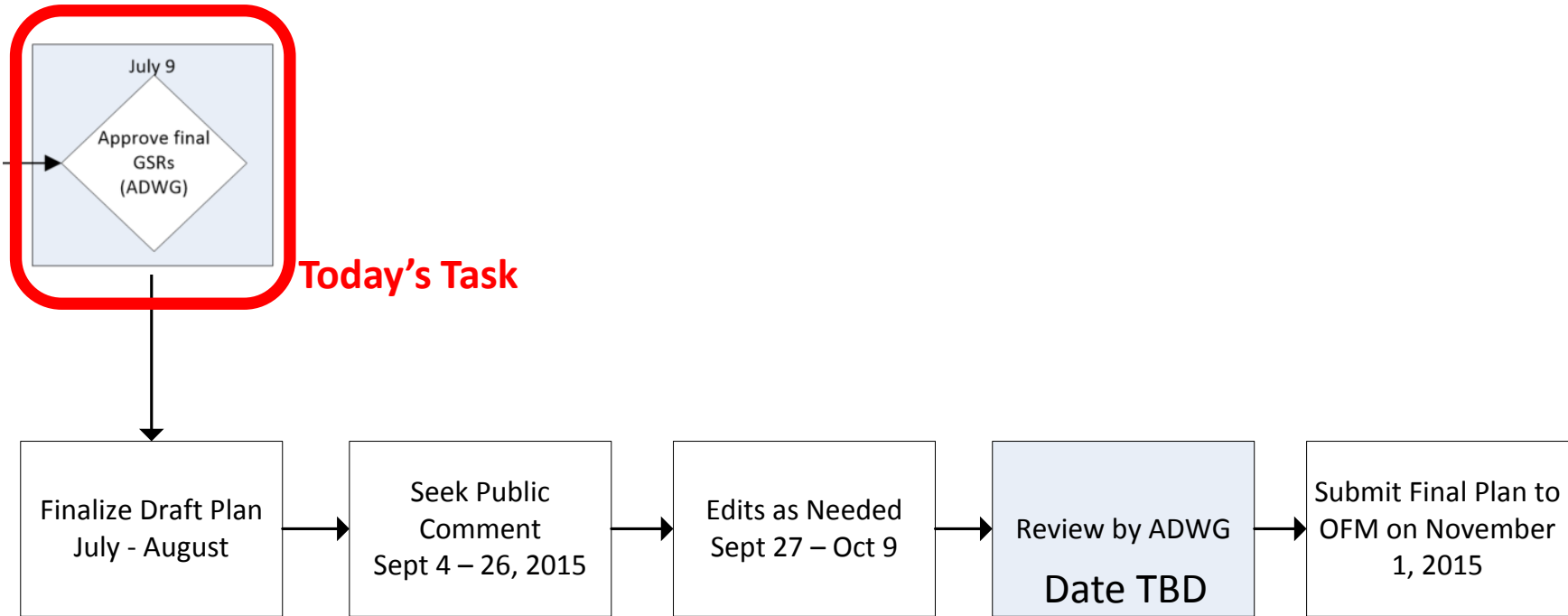

# Implementation Plan Highlights

1. Proposal to establish a 2<sup>nd</sup> generation ADWG advisory group
2. Create a Steering Committee (DSHS, DOH, HCA, Alzheimer's Association, Alzheimer's Society, ElderCare Alliance, Governor's Office), administratively housed at DSHS
3. Submit progress report to legislature annually
4. Create and maintain a network of advocates and experts to help implement and support the plan
