McFeat started her social work career in Tacoma and served as the strategic planner/program manager for the Port Gamble S'Klallam Tribe's reentry program, creating a nationally recognized reentry program using evidence-based practices and a people-first human dignity model where her team's work reduced recidivism by over 80% in their target population. She is a White House Champion for Change nominee and recipient of the Linda Gabriel Human Rights Award, among numerous other honors, for her leading work with formerly incarcerated people, and their families.
