This course provides the knowledge, skills and practice to prepare students for the HCA certification written and skills exams. Available resources include a model OSPI CTE Framework (90-hour) and the course curriculum in 13 languages. Flexibility is provided, within the framework, for Tribes to include Traditional practices and values.
